One: So now we are ready to be put out to sea.

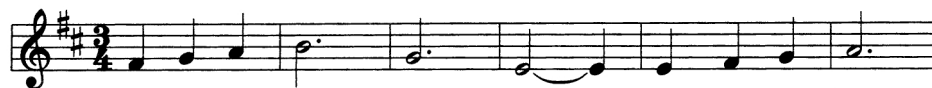
All: Help us to cast our bread upon the water.

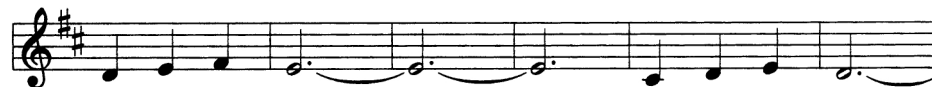

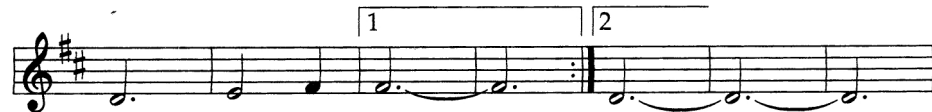
